- at different level of integration in the skills ecosystem

Identify high quality **performance** for a broad range of activities





Spot Inter-institutional multipliers of Vocational Excellence


Detect high organisational capacity to improve, innovate and grow

















#### How to recognise Vocational

#### **Excellence: preliminary**

#### reflections





- Recognises large number of CoVEs
- Helps to clarify identity and status as CoVE
- Compliance with a 'minimum' number of quality criteria
- Broad measure of excellence
- Inclusive

- Relatively few award winners
- Identify outstanding practices and achievements
- Provision of specific evidence
- Focus on different kinds of excellence

#### **Recognise Excellence: different scenarios**



A simple labelling system for quality in VET excellence

A labelling system with different maturity levels (e.g. silver, bronze, gold)

An Award for the general concept of VET excellence

Awards for different types of excellence (e.g. collaboration, improvement, innovation, etc.)


The current hypothesis







